Purpose of the role:

Main responsibilities:

- Take photographs of Baytree activities, workshops, events and celebrations.
- Share selected images with Communications Team in timely manner.
- Adhere to Baytree's safeguarding, consent and privacy policies.

Skills and qualities required:

- Able to provide and use their own camera equipment.
- Confident using a camera and taking high-quality photographs.
- Comfortable working with diverse cultural backgrounds.
- Reliable, punctual, and well-organised.
- Able to work independently and in a team.
- Flexible and willing to support varied tasks.

Desirable:

- Experience in event, portrait, or documentary photography.
- Interest in charity, education, or community development.
- Basic photo editing skills.
- Experience volunteering or working in a community setting.

Commitment:

- Flexible – once a month (Monday–Thursday), two hours between 10:00 am – 6:00 pm.
- 4 to 6 months during term time, with flexibility to extend.

Benefits: *We reimburse up to £7 for travel and £5 for lunch expenses for each full day of internship.*

- Develop skills in visual storytelling and explore photography genres.
